Psalms 139:1-18 (ESV) ¹O Lord, you have searched me and known me! ²You know when I sit down and when I rise up; you discern my thoughts from afar. ³You search out my path and my lying down and are acquainted with all my ways. ⁴Even before a word is on my tongue, behold, O Lord, you know it altogether. ⁵You hem me in, behind and before, and lay your hand upon me. ⁶Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; it is high; I cannot attain it. ⁷Where shall I go from your Spirit? Or where shall I flee from your presence? ⁸If I ascend to heaven, you are there! If I make my bed in Sheol, you are there! ⁹If I take the wings of the morning and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, ¹⁰even there your hand shall lead me, and your right hand shall hold me. ¹¹If I say, "Surely the darkness shall cover me, and the light about me be night," 12 even the darkness is not dark to you; the night is bright as the day, for darkness is as light with you. ¹³For you formed my inward parts; you knitted me together in my mother's womb. ¹⁴I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Psalms 95:6 (NKJV) ⁶Oh come, let us worship and bow down; Let us kneel before the Lord our Maker.

ALL-POWERFUL

Psalms 19:1-4 (NKJV) ¹ The heavens declare the glory of God; And the firmament shows His handiwork. ²Day unto day utters speech, And night unto night reveals knowledge. ³There is no speech nor language *where* their voice is not heard. ⁴Their [£]line has gone out through all the earth, And their words to the end of the world.

Revelation 19:6 (NKJV) 6 And I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude, as the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty thunderings, saying, "Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns!

ALL-WISE

Romans 11:33 (NKJV) ³³Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable *are* His judgments and His ways past finding out!

Proverbs 2:4-8 (NKJV) ⁴ If you seek her as silver, And search for her as *for* hidden treasures; ⁵ Then you will understand the fear of the Lord, And find the knowledge of God. ⁶ For the Lord gives wisdom; From His mouth *come* knowledge and understanding; ⁷ He stores up sound

Jeremiah 23:23-24 (NKJV) ²³ "Am I a God near at hand," says the Lord, "And not a God afar off? ²⁴ Can anyone hide himself in secret places, So I shall not see him?" says the Lord; "Do I not fill heaven and earth?" says the Lord.

Psalms 23:1-4 (NKJV) ¹ The Lord *is* my shepherd; I shall not want. ² He makes me to lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside the still waters. ³ He restores my soul; He leads me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake. ⁴ Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You *are* with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.

ALL-LOVING

1 John 4:8 (NKJV) ⁸He who does not love does not know God, for God is love.

1 John 4:16 (NKJV) ¹⁶And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him.\

HOLY, HOLY, HOLY

Isaiah 6:1-5 (NKJV) ¹In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His *robe* filled the temple. ²Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. ³And one cried to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy *is* the Lord of hosts; The whole earth *is* full of His glory!" ⁴And the posts of the door were shaken by the voice of him who cried out, and the house was filled with smoke. ⁵So I said: "Woe *is* me, for I am undone! Because I *am* a man of unclean lips, And I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, The Lord of hosts."

1 Peter 1:15-16 (NKJV) ¹⁵but as He who called you *is* holy, you also be holy in all *your* conduct, ¹⁶because it is written, *"Be holy, for I am holy."*

FAITHFUL

Psalms 89:1-2 (NKJV) ¹ I will sing of the mercies of the Lord forever; With my mouth will I make known Your faithfulness to all generations. ² For I have said, "Mercy shall be built up forever; Your faithfulness You shall establish in the very heavens."

2 Timothy 2:11-13 (NKJV) ¹¹*This is* a faithful saying: For if we died with *Him,* We shall also live with *Him.* ¹² If we endure, We shall also reign with *Him.* If we deny *Him,* He also will deny us. ¹³ If we are faithless, He remains faithful; He cannot deny Himself.

GENEROUS FATHER

Matthew 7:9-12 (NKJV) ⁹Or what man is there among you who, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone? ¹⁰Or if he asks for a fish, will he give him a serpent? ¹¹If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him! ¹²Therefore, whatever you want men to do to you, do also to them, for this is the Law and the Prophets.

GOOD & SEVERE

Romans 11:22 (NKJV) ²²Therefore consider the goodness and severity of God: on those who fell, severity; but toward you, $\frac{\epsilon}{2}$ goodness, if you continue in *His* goodness. Otherwise you also will be cut off.

Hebrews 12:28-29 (NKJV) ²⁸Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we $\frac{f}{2}$ may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear. ²⁹For our God *is* a consuming fire.

An eternal home awaiting

2 Corinthians 4:16-18 (NKJV) ¹⁶Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day. ¹⁷For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory, ¹⁸while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal.

Love that never ends

1 Corinthians 13:8 (ESV) ⁸Love never ends....**1 Corinthians 13:13 (ESV)** So now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; but the greatest of these is love.

Romans 5:5 (NKJV) Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

Instruction in righteousness; avoid consequences of a life of sin

Psalms 119:97-101 (NKJV) ⁹⁷Oh, how I love Your law! It *is* my meditation all the day. ⁹⁸You, through Your commandments, make me wiser than my enemies; For they *are* ever with me. ⁹⁹I have more understanding than all my teachers, For Your testimonies *are* my meditation. ¹⁰⁰I understand more than the ancients, Because I keep Your precepts. ¹⁰¹I have restrained my feet from every evil way, That I may keep Your word.

Close fellowship of caring people

Romans 12:10-13 (NKJV) ¹⁰Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another; ¹¹not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord; ¹²rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer; ¹³distributing to the needs of the saints, given to hospitality.

Faithful, loyal friends

Proverbs 18:24 (NKJV) 24 A man *who has* friends $^{\underline{\epsilon}}$ must himself be friendly, But there is a friend *who* sticks closer than a brother.

Opportunities to give and serve

Acts 20:35 (NKJV) ³⁵I have shown you in every way, by laboring like this, that you must support the weak. And remember the words of the Lord Jesus, that He said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'"

Wisdom and help in difficult times

James 1:5 (NKJV) ⁵If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.

Psalms 127:1 (NKJV) ¹Unless the Lord builds the house, They labor in vain who build it;

Peace that passes understanding

Philippians 4:6-7 (ESV) ⁶do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. ⁷And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

1 Peter 1:8 (NKJV) ⁸ whom having not seen you love. Though now you do not see *Him,* yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory,
